

Item No. 1: Welcome of members of CDC by Principal

Principal welcomed Hon. Shri. Ashokbhai Merchant, Chairman of the College Development Committee, other nominees of management, and staff representatives present for the meeting. Hon. Shri. Ashokbhai Merchant joined the meeting in an online manner.

Item No. 2: Confirmation and approve the minutes of last CDC Meeting

Resolution: The copies of agenda, minutes of meeting of last CDC meeting and relevant documents were circulated to all members. Principal read out the minutes of last CDC meeting held on 23rd March 2024 along with the action taken report. The minutes were confirmed and approved after a word to that effect by all members. Members also discussed the Action Taken Report based on the last CDC meeting.

Item no. 3: Presentation of report of various activities by Principal.

Resolution: Dr. Nandurkar appraised the members about the brief summary of various activities and achievements of staff and students since the last CDC meeting. Some of the important activities undertaken by the institute include:

- Admission of UG and PG program (AY 2024-25)
- Placement and internships statistics from A.Y. 2019-20 to A.Y. 2023-24
- Details of departmental events held from 4th to 6th April 2024
- Extension of NBA accreditation of Mechanical Engineering Department for a period of three years up to 30th June 2027
- Details of the project exhibition cum contest held for the students
- Visit of senior faculty to the Gujarat Technological University (GTU) on 9th May 2024
- Felicitation of places students
- Expert talks, seminars, webinars, training sessions, competitions, exhibitions, panel discussions and workshops arranged in the institute, industry interactions, and visit of eminent persons to the institute and Idea Lab
- Celebration of Yoga Day on 21st June 2024
- Admission counselling sessions arranged for the prospective students at various locations in the State
- Death Anniversary of Late Shri. Kakusheth Udeshi on 9th July 2024
- Joint Anniversary Program of Late Karmaveer Kakasaheb Wagh, Late Tatyasaheb Borasate & Late Kakusheth Udeshi held in the institute on 22nd July 2024
- College Magazine HORIZON-2023 secured third position in the Professional Category at the University Level (SPPU, Pune) for the AY 2022-23
- Staff and student achievements

Members appreciated the activities undertaken by the institute especially admission promotion sessions, panel discussions, research grants and other achievements. Shri. Chaphekar said that the cut-off of the institute has improved significantly. Good recruitment has been made by the core industries and placements are satisfactory. Shri, Waghulde suggested that the institute should now concentrate on commercialization of the patents.

Item no. 4: Approval of workload for AY 2024-25

Resolution: Prof. Mankar informed that new workload for AY 2024-25 has been approved by the University. She said that approval of the new workload was necessary owing to natural growth and increase in intake in some branches. Around 257 faculty members are required in A.Y. 2024-25 considering the current intake of 1314.

Members took a note of the workload approved for A.Y. 2024-25.

Item No. 5: Plan of induction program for First Year Engineering UG AY 2024-25

Resolution: Prof Mankar presented the induction program plan for First Year Engineering UG AY 2024-25. She said that the induction program will be arranged as follows:

- Online Mode Induction Program from 2nd Sept. to 6th Sept. 2024
- Offline Mode Induction Program from 9th Sept. to 16th Sept. 2024
- Bridging program 'Concept Café' from 9th Sept. to 16th Sept. 2024

She also presented various activities proposed under the online, offline and social awareness program. Members took note of the proposed plan and gave their consent for conduction of these programs.

Item no. 6: Plan of First Year admission promotion for AY 2024-25

Resolution: Dr. Vijay Patil briefed the members about the admission promotion activities undertaken by the institute. He said that the institute has obtained a database of around 5000 students from College Dunia. Data of prospective students is also collected by admission representatives from various places. The names of the prospective students have been distributed to all teaching and non-teaching staff for necessary follow up. Besides Nashik, counselling sessions will be held at Chatrapati Sambhajinagar, Ahmednagar, Dhule, Jalgaon and Buldhana.

> Prof. Patil said that awareness will be created through digital marketing, social media groups, institute website, hoardings and posters, newspaper articles and advertisements, Radio and TV advertisement, and leads obtained through College Dunia. He said that the institute also plans to undertake activities such as lectures / panel discussion by industry experts, felicitation of placed students, group visits to the feeder institutes and visit to various institutes by coordinators. A pre-admission software designed by professionals is used for the admission related activities.

> Members appreciated the efforts of the institute in creating awareness amongst the prospective students and gave their consent for arranging the admission promotion activities.

Item no. 7: Starting of courses for working professional from AY 2024-25

Resolution: Members were informed that the institute has received permission for starting following courses for working professional from AY 2024-25

Electrical Engineering: Intake 30

Computer Engineering: Intake 30

It was informed that the syllabus for these courses will be same as that for the regular students. The courses will be conducted in the evening and on the weekdays or holidays.

Members gave their consent for stating these courses from AY 2024-25

Item no. 8: Academic approval and appointment of senior faculty for some departments

Resolution: Dr. Dhake informed that the institute has sent a proposal for continuation of academic approval of 40 faculty members for AY 2024-25 to the University. This includes 32 Assistant Professors, 05 Associate Professors and 03 Professors. It was informed that 18 faculty, 02 Physical Director/Assistant Physical Director and 01 Librarian were selected recently as per the workload.

Members gave their consent for these appointments.

Item no. 9: Development status of Innovation Centre and other proposals

Resolution: Dr. Dhake apprised the members about the development status of the Innovation Centre. He presented the yearly plan and the status of work completed, work in progress and monthly plan. He also briefed the members about the current lab status, activities at the Idea Lab, Industry Awareness program, training imparted to the teachers, visit of eminent persons to the lab and summary of research proposals submitted to various agencies since 2019.

> Members appreciated the efforts of the institute and faculty in the development of the Idea Lab.

Item No. 10: Recommendation by members for excellence in academic, curricular and co-curricular activities.

Resolution: Principal Dr. K. N. Nandurkar requested the members to share their views. Shri. Waghulde enquired whether there are any projects in the area of renewable energy. Shri. Chaphekar said that we should try to identify the reasons why students seek admission at other places when they can get good education in Nashik. He suggested commercialization of the AICTE Idea Lab activities and collaboration with the industry.

Item no. 11: Any other point with permission of the Chair

Resolution: Members appreciated the institute initiative in starting the undergraduate engineering program for the working professionals. A wide publicity should be given to this program. Mr. Chaphekar suggested that the institute can also think of launching an Executive MBA program in future.

Item No. 12: Vote of thanks

With no other point for discussion, and with permission of chair, Prof. Dr. Dinesh Chandwadkar proposed vote of thanks and the meeting were declared over.
