2. Online session on "My Journey to Higher Study in Germany by Mr. Kalpesh Baviskar, an Alumnus of KKWIEER from Mechanical Engineering Department", on Thursday, 25 June 2020 at 5.15 PM.

This Online guidance session was organized by International Facilitation Centre of KKWIEER, Nashik in which an **Alumnus of our institute Mr. Kalpesh Baviskar** (Passed out in 2016 from Mechanical Engineering Department and who is **currently pursuing his MS in Business Administration from University of Rome and has completed MA in International Management from SRH Hochschule University in Berlin from Germany**) guided the students on Thursday, 25 June 2020 at 5.15.PM (90 Minutes) on an Online platform of Zoom.

Mr. Kalpesh Baviskar, IFC Coordinator Prof. A. S. Patil, IFC Co-coordinator Prof. A. V. Kolapker and Prof. S. S. Banait along with 41 students were present for this online guidance session. Prof. A. S. Patil has initiated the session with a short introduction of Mr. Kalpesh Baviskar and the objective of the online session. Mr. Kalpesh Baviskar has also prepared an excellent presentation on the points and queries shared by Prof. A. S. Patil through a google spread sheet to him prior to the session. He has said that Dr. Nandurkar Sir, Dr. Shahbadkar Sir and all KKWIEER staff have guided him and his batchmates in an excellent way due to which they have been selected in good companies and then to higher study abroad also. He also appreciated the efforts taken by Training and Placement office of our institute to train and place them in a good company. He has explained the various points in a very simple and understandable manner so that all the participants can get an idea of his journey to higher study in Germany.

The following points were discussed in detail by Mr. Kalpesh Baviskar,

1. He has shared the reasons for doing higher study at abroad like getting an exposure to International community, getting job opportunities, learning a different culture, travelling experience etc.
2. He shared some salient points which students should look upon as a part of higher study preparation like planning of it as early as possible during second/third year only, time management, coaching class requirement, best resources of studies and minimum



requirements of passing the International Examinations like GRE/GMAT/TOEFL/IELTS etc.

3. The selection of the course should depend on career goals of student like Technical/Management, targeted country, listing of top universities in that country as per choice of course, compare the pros and cons of each program and also the subjects offered in every course.
4. About selection of a proper University he has told that students should concentrate on Economy of Country where they want to pursue their higher study, Public or Private Nature of it, location of University, and recognition of the course, tuition fees etc. He also discussed about the Erasmus Opportunities and Scholarship facility by the various Universities.
5. After this he has explained about the necessary and important things like basic qualification, English Competency Tests, Eligibility Tests, Job Experience Requirement and the various documents needed for the application purpose in context with the higher study abroad.
6. He has also shared about the mini jobs, part time jobs options, working students in part time manner and full time internships opportunities to the students.
7. He has also shared some of tips and tricks like searching of higher study material on their own, say no to Counsellors, learn the language of the destination country, visits the websites of the targeted Universities and check for the Universities which will give you an excellent education and internships or job opportunities,
8. He has also shared approximate expenses required for doing higher study in Germany as well as in Europe.
9. At the end he has answered the queries and doubts raised by the participating students as well as teachers.

At the end of the session Prof. Patil A. S. has given vote of thanks and requested Mr. Kalpesh Baviskar to guide the students of KKWIEER in near future in the similar way. He has agreed to guide the students as per the requirements of them in an online or offline manner. Prof. s. S. Banait and Prof. A. V. Kolapkar has also requested him to be in touch with the institute and guide the students.

12. First batch students Japanese language (N5 level) Devang Vyas, Kushal Dogra have expressed their views regarding the learning experience with a satisfaction.





8. He has also shared the Top National Universities in Japan and told that nearly 350 Universities are present in Japan and taking care of technical advancement of their Country.
9. He has also thrown light on the economy of Japan and the job availability in Japan and motivated the students to learn Japanese language at least up to N3 level to get a good job in Japanese Companies.
10. At the end he has shared his views regarding the development of a research culture amongst the students and staff.
11. He has appealed the students to start preparing right now for getting admitted in good Universities around the world.
12. He has also given information about the financial budget required for getting admission in Japanese Universities. He has also told that a student from an average income family can get the admission depending upon the academic record of the student. 5. Online Guidance Session on “Higher Study and Job opportunities in USA” By. Mr. Dushyant Shindore, Mr. Sagar Kothawade and Mr. Rohan Joshi Saturday, 12 September 2020 at 7.00 PM

This Online guidance session was organized by International Facilitation Centre of KKWIEER, Nashik in which **Alumni of our institute Mr. Dushyant Shindore, Mr. Sagar Kothawade and Mr. Rohan Joshi** (Passed out in 2009 from Mechanical Engineering Department and who had completed their higher studies from USA and are **currently working with the US Multinational Organizations in India and USA**) have guided the students on Saturday, 12 September 2020 at 7.00 PM through an Online platform of Zoom.

Mr. Dushyant Shindore (Design Engineer working with USA Based MNC), Mr. Sagar Kothawade (Supply Chain Specialist, Entercoms Inc., Pune) and Mr. Rohan Joshi (FEA Analyst in USA based MNC), Principal Dr. K. N. Nandurkar Sir, IFC Coordinator Prof. A. S. Patil and Prof. A. V. Kolapker along with 42 students were present for this online guidance session. Prof. A. S. Patil has initiated the session with a short introduction of all three Experts and stated the objective of the online session. Mr. Dushyant Sir, Mr. Sagar Sir and Mr. Rohan Sir has also prepared an excellent presentation on the related points for guiding the students. Initially all the three Experts have shared their experiences and current scenario going on about their individual activities in short during discussion. Dr. K. N. Nandurkar Sir has guided on this occasion and ask the Experts to be in touch with the institute for sharing their knowledge to the students as and when required as per their convenience. All the three Experts have appreciated the efforts taken by KKWIEER and emphasized on Hands on Training, Internship in industries and live projects like SAE BAJA and others are the key parameters to get admitted to Higher Study or getting jobs in MNC's. They have also explained the various points related to the topic of discussion in a very simple and understandable manner so that all the participants can get an idea of it.

The following points were discussed in detail by Mr. Dushyant Sir, Mr. Sagar Sir and Mr. Rohan Sir,

1. Mr. Dushyant has shared his views about the requirements of the Higher study preparations for USA like eligibility criterion, Examinations need to be cleared, required cut off scores, significance of Statement of Purpose, Curriculum Vitae and Letter of



Recommendation and framing of all these in a proper manner while applying to concern Universities,

2. He has also guided about the significance of work experience from any industry and experience of working on live projects which is really helpful to get admitted in a good University.
3. He has also shared the time lines of the admissions for both the semesters for the USA Universities and advised the students to follow the same.
4. Mr. Sagar has shared his views about the various options available for the students related to Master degree in USA. He shared some salient points which students should look upon as a part of higher study preparation like planning of it as early as possible during second/third year only, time management, coaching class requirement, best resources of studies and minimum requirements of passing the International Examinations like GRE/GMAT/TOEFL/IELTS etc.
5. He has shared his views on significance of Internships and hands on training experience requirement for getting admitted in Tier I and Tier II USA universities. He has advised that students should not do any non-technical jobs for earning purpose unless and until it is very necessary rather they should focus on getting Research Assistantship in the University campus itself.
6. He has also guided the students about the pattern of higher study course, different courses available in the US universities, flexibility of switching from one domain to another domain of interest and the overall information of the courses in US Universities.
7. He has also guided the students about the necessary requirements of managing the financial aspects, funding agencies available for the same and total expenses needs to be done till the end of the course. He has advised students that try to be very well prepared and ready with a good financial back up plan which will be required for doing higher study in USA.
8. He has also guided the students about the availability of jobs in USA after doing higher study. He said that the companies are not conducting campus placement in US Universities but the student needs to apply individually as per their expertise for getting



- jobs. He said that the Computer and Information Technology students will be getting higher job opportunities in USA as compared to core branches like Mechanical, Civil etc.
9. Mr. Rohan has shared his views about the Visa processing and the significance of various aspects about it in short.
 10. He has also guided about the requirements of getting a Green Card, restrictions associated with the VISA approval from US Consulate and the various Political and Economic aspects and its implications for getting US Visa's.
 11. He has also guided the students about the permission of further higher study by USA Government and extension of the Visa for the same in order to utilize the intellectual brains for the development of their country by offering the Research Opportunities to eligible students.
 12. He has also shared his experiences of learning and working in the USA and shared the various aspects of getting jobs in USA after successful completion of Higher Study.
 13. He has also shared the information about the availability of job opportunities in various USA states as per the field of expertise of the students or individuals.
 14. Mr. Dushyant has shared his views regarding KKWIEER's memories of him and said that sincere and dedicated efforts in study, involvement in the practical aspects of various concepts and following the guidelines of faculty are the most important things to succeed in a your academics.
 15. Mr. Sagar has said that working with a SAE BAJA Team was a turning point in his life as it has enriched him with full of technical and managerial experience. It was one of the most important thing with which he had selected for BOSCH and also for Higher Study in USA.
 16. Rohan has also told that working with SAE BAJA Team has contributed a lot in getting admitted in an excellent USA University for higher study.
 17. All the three Experts have answered to the questions and queries raised by the students about the higher study and Jobs in USA like process of admission, management of financial aspects, internship facilities availability, part time jobs, total expenses required, eligibility criterion, cut off requirements for various examination scores, Public and Private University requirements etc.

6. Participation in a Global Virtual Fair organized by AEC and Study Smart Education, Pune on 3/10/2020 from 11.00 AM to 5.00 PM.

Prof. A. S. Patil, IFC Coordinator of KKWIEER, Nashik has Participated in an Online Higher Study Abroad- Education Fair by AEC and Study Smart Education, Pune and discussed with 7 University officials regarding the higher study requirements and procedure for the respective Universities. Also 2-3 students of KKWIEER have also participated in this fair individually and interacted with the various Universities officials.

The interaction with the 7 Foreign University Representatives has given good insights about the various things as given below,

- University of Glasgow, United Kingdom has shared the various program details available in their University, Fees structure, Scholarship schemes, internship facility etc. and wished to conduct a separate guidance session for the interested students of our institute. The approximate education and living expenses may be up to Rs. 30 Lakh to 40 Lakh for getting education
- University of Leeds, United Kingdom representative Ms. Manisha Tanwar guided regarding the Programs like Mechatronics and Robotics for Mechanical and Electronics students, The content like technical background, career goals, achievements, no use of flurry language, skill set attained etc. should be a part of SOP.
- Mount Saint Vincent University, CANADA representative has shared the information about the University and said that there is no scope for engineering students to get admission in their University as they are offering only Health, Communication, and Media Programs.
- Cape Breton University, CANADA representative has shared the details of Programs/Courses available at their University, Fees structure for the various programs, Scholarship and Internships offered by their University. He has told that the Engineering Programs in Petroleum, Industrial Engineering. Materials etc. are offered by this University. UG program in Business Management after 12 Standard is also available. The job opportunities available for Petroleum engineering students. The educational expenses are approximately Rs. 30-35 lakh for two years apart from living expenses.



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- Trinity College, Dublin (which is a Public University) representative has explained about programs available in their University like M. Sc. In Data Science, Network System, Cyber Security, Augmented and Virtual Reality, Mechanical Engineering Programs, Civil Engineering Programs in Structural and Geology etc. The fees structure and living expenses were also shared by him which is approximately Rs. 30 Lakh to 35 Lakh.
- James Cook University, Singapore representative has shared the details of their University and said that the IT Engineers have scope to do higher study at JCU in the programs like Business Information, Computer Networking, Games and Animation etc. Also the Environmental Science graduates can do their higher study in JCU. He has also shared the approximate expenses required for doing higher study at JCU.
- New Castle University, England representative has shared the programs like Marine Engineering, Materials Engineering, Mechanical Engineering, Computer Engineering, Chemical Engineering etc. available in their University having the duration of one year and approximate fees of Rs. 25 Lakh to 30 Lakh. The University's National Institute Centre offers programs in Data Science, Artificial Intelligence, Statistics etc. The scholarship facility is available course or program wise and students can avail the benefit of it.

International Facilitation Centre of KKWIEER, Nashik has organized **An Online Session on “Higher Study in Germany” By Mr. Chirag B. Patil Mr. Chirag Patil who is an Alumnus of KKWIEER (2019 Batch) and currently pursuing his Higher Study (M. S. in Operational Excellence- MBA and Engineering) at Hof University** of Applied Sciences, Hochschule, Germany on Sunday, 18 October 2020 at 7.00 PM (90 Minutes) on an online platform of Zoom.

Mr. Chirag B. Patil, Respected Principal Dr. K. N. Nandurkar, IFC Coordinator Prof. A. S. Patil, IFC Co-coordinator Prof. A. V. Kolapker along with nearly 37 students were present for this online guidance session. Prof. A. S. Patil has initiated the session with a short introduction of Mr. Chirag Patil and the objective of organizing this online session. Mr. Chirag Patil has also prepared an excellent presentation on the points and queries shared by Prof. A. S. Patil through a google spread sheet to him prior to the session. He has explained the various points in a very simple and understandable manner so that all the participants can get an idea of the various aspects related to Higher Study requirements in Germany.

The following points were discussed in detail by Mr. Chirag B. Patil,

1. He has shared his views on the preparatory requirements for the preparation of Higher Study at Germany and advised that students need to start the preparation of it very early during Second or Third Year of their academic tenure.
2. He suggested that students should look for the University which offers the Program of their interest, time management, coaching class requirement, best resources of studies and minimum requirements of passing the International Examinations like GRE/TOEFL/IELTS etc.



3. He has given emphasis on significance of German Language and asked the students to learn it up to maximum possible levels so that it can add value to their resume which ultimately help them to get admitted in a reputed University.
4. He has asked the students to refer the DAAD Portal which gives various details about the Programs and Courses offered by German Universities so that students can get required information under one roof.
5. He has explained the various details of documentation needed for getting admitted in the German Universities through a Checklist like preparation of Resume, Statement of Purpose, Transcripts from University, Recommendation Letters, Mark sheets, Extra Curricular Certificates, Experience Certificates, Pass Port Details, Rank Certificate etc.
6. He also shared the procedure to get Visa for Germany and significance of required documents in this process which should be submitted in a proper ordered manner to the Visa Office to avoid the rejection of it. He has also shared the various hurdles which generally many of the students face while getting the VISA approval.
7. About selection of a proper University he has told that students should concentrate on choice of their course and accordingly go for selection of University. He has also discussed about the Scholarship facility provided by the Hof University and told the students that the scholarship will be provided on the basis of academic excellence of students in every academic semester but it will be applicable to certain number of students due to the Merit requirement.
8. After this he has explained about English Competency Tests, German language requirement, Eligibility Tests and Job Experience Requirement needed for the application purpose in context with the higher study in Germany.
9. He has also shared his views about in campus and off campus part time job availability as per German Government rules and advised the students that instead of doing Non-Technical Jobs students should concentrate on to the Program for which they have enrolled in the University.
10. He has also shared his suggestions like doing the preparation at own, try to avoid the Counselor help, Learn the German language, search on websites of the decided






The details summary is as follows,





4. He has also shared the difference between the GRE and GMAT examination and its preparation guidelines to all the students.


1. He has shared some historical and geographical details of France and significance of it in the European Union. The role of Campus France in India has been explained by him in short.

PART B- Foreign Language Training Sessions

- IFC has conducted the counseling session and guided the students for the enrollment of foreign language courses which were framed by the KKWIEER and I-Pro EDU, Nashik.
- The permission for initiating the German (A1 and A2 level) and Japanese (N5 and N4 Level) language course was sought from Principal, KKWIEER, Nashik and the finance details are sanctioned from Finance Manager of KKWES, Nashik.
- It has been decided to charge Rs.5000/- for German A1 level and Japanese N5 level as well as Rs.7500 for German A2 level and Japanese N4 Level as per MoU clauses.
- As per the appeal made to the students 15 have enrolled for the German language A1 level course and 14 students have enrolled for German A2 level course which is started on 5 August 2020.
- These two **new batches of German A1 and A2 levels are still going** on and will most **probably end in the third week of November**.
- The student has been benefitted with the good amount of concession in terms training fees for these sessions with the prior approval from the KKWIEER office by inviting the quotations from the different service providers. Students have also given the sufficient time for the deposition of fees due to Pandemic Situation.
- All the fees has been deposited in KKWIEER account by the students though online mode and after Successful completion of course, Passing of I Pro EDU examination, declaration of result and certificate distribution to all the passed out students the amount (as per MOU) will be disbursed to I Pro EDU by submitting a short report and required financial documents to KKWIEER accounts office.
- Due to pandemic situation all the classes of A1 and A2 level German language are going on in an online manner through a ZOOM platform along with other online tools used by I Pro EDU for the conduction of tests and evaluation of student's performance.

Bei meiner Ankunft in Deutschland vor einem Jahr war ich ziemlich überrascht, wie einfach bestimmte Sachen sind, z. B. die Anmeldung an der Uni oder im Wohnheim. Die Mitarbeiter waren freundlich und hilfsbereit und nirgends musste ich lange warten.

Aber im Verkehr und auf den Straßen ist es eigentlich schon richtig. Wenn der Bus um 9.12 Uhr abfahren soll, dann fährt er (meistens) auch um 9.12 Uhr ab. Das macht das Leben weniger stressig – aber dafür fehlt auch ein Grund, wenn man zu spät kommt :-)

Das Leben hier gefällt mir sehr gut. Die Studenten sind interessiert und nett und ich habe schon neue Freunde gefunden. Sie haben mir schon vieles hier gezeigt und finden es nicht schlimm, wenn ich etwas nicht verstehe.

Manchmal bin ich auf Partys eingeladen und jeder soll dann etwas zu essen und zu trinken mitbringen. Das kann ich nicht verstehen! Wenn ich Freunde einlade, dann möchte ich ihnen etwas anbieten – sie sind doch meine Gäste! Aber eine Sache daran ist gut: Eine Party machen ist hier billiger, und als Studenten haben wir natürlich alle nicht viel Geld.

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

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
