Minutes of Meeting

IQAC meeting of K. K. Wagh Institute of Engineering Education and Research, Nashik was held under the Chairmanship of Dr. K. N. Nandurkar, Director, KKWIEER on Wednesday 26th June 2024 at 3:00 pm in IQAC hall.

1) Welcome to all members

Dr. P. D. Bhamre welcomed Mr. Rohit Kulkarni, Mr. Sunil Bhor and Mr. Nilesh Salgaonkar.

2) Confirmation of Minutes of previous IQAC Meeting

Resolution: The copies of agenda, minutes of meeting of last IQAC meeting and relevant documents were circulated to all members. Prof. N. M. Shahane read out the minutes of last meeting along with action taken. The minutes were confirmed and approved.

Dr. P. D. Bhamre briefed the members about MKCL LearnLive the new features introduced. She has also informed about the idea of VTFR

Mr. Salgaonkar curiously asked about the Psychometric Test. Dr. P. D. Bhamre provided the necessary information.

Mr. Salgaonkar proposed to conduct a test to find probable job profiling. He has suggested to refer to mettl.com. Mr. Sangle added that it should include the activities done by the students in the last four years. Mr. Bhor reminded about school test done at 10th std and suggested using software for the

the same. Mr. Sangle suggested to use agencies by means of signing MOU. Mr. Bhor added that existing agencies can be identified.

Mr. Salgaonkar advised to provide extra training to students regarding industrial perspective of Quality, purchase etc.

Mr. Sangle asked about Evaluation process. Dr. P. D. Bhamre informed about it. Mr. Salgaonkar posed a question that can we have only LMS TEST instead of End-Sem exam. He has also suggested to have a score of a teacher.

Mr. Rohit shared his experience that students' coding/programming skills have not improved. He said that coding implies understanding improves one's logic. He expressed deep worries about study pattern of today's engg students and their use of ChatGPT, Question Bank etc and posed a question: Where are we going


Mr. Sangle discussed Binary Evaluation in NAAC. Mr. Salgaonkar added about Quality of Curriculum in Autonomous status. Dr. Nandurkar informed the members about BOS and support of industry in designing the curriculum and added that there is no third party evaluation. Mr. Salgaonkar asked about industry relevance. He said hard core principles of Electrical Engg are required and also DSP. He suggested that Curriculum should match with Quality Objective of institute. Dr. Nandurkar informed that curriculum is to be designed as per Graduate Aptitudes and its mapping requires justification based on SWOT Analysis. Prof. N. M. Shahane informed that in NBA there are highest marks for Curriculum Design. He also informed about POs as framed by AICTE and about PSOs. Dr. Nandurkar concluded that there is a scope to improve in the light of NEP. All the members agreed.


6) Any other point with permission of the chair
