Minutes of Meeting

IQAC meeting of K. K. Wagh Institute of Engineering Education and Research, Nashik was held under the Chairmanship of Dr. K. N. Nandurkar, Director, KKWIEER on Tuesday 29th October 2024 at 2:00 pm in IQAC hall.

1) Welcome to all members

Dr. P. D. Bhamre welcomed Mr. Rohit Kulkarni and Mr. Sunil Bhor.

2) Confirmation of Minutes of previous IQAC Meeting

Resolution: The copies of agenda, minutes of meeting of last IQAC meeting and relevant documents were circulated to all members. Prof. N. M. Shahane read out the minutes of last meeting along with action taken. The minutes were confirmed and approved.

3) Review of IQAC activities (July 2024 to Oct 2024)

Prof. N. M. Shahane presented review of IQAC activities conducted during July 2024 to Oct 2024. He has briefly reported the following activities carried out in last four months.

Dr.P.D.Bhamre briefed on status of final year project reviews of all departments and its comparison with previous 3 years along with percentage improvements. Dr. K. N. Nandurkar expressed concern about the delay in progress of final year projects for each review. Dr.P.D.Bhamre has also provided LMS review for FY, SY and TY B-Tech classes and congratulated Mechanical Engineering Department for its highest performance.

Dr.P.D.Bhamre briefed on 9 days Concept Cafe Program scheduled during 10 to 21 Sept 2024 for FY BTech 2024-25 along with students' feedback. This program covers essential concepts of



Mathematics, Physics, Chemistry. It involves 42 teachers and 1050 students in different sessions of total 286 hours in 17 divisions. Dr. P. D. Bhamre briefed about Students Satisfaction Survey (SSS) and presented comparison of it for the AY 2022-2023 and 2023-2024 with 5 sample questions.

5) Open discussions

Mr. Rohit Kulkarni expressed concern about attendance of the students and briefed about non-classroom activities. Dr. K. N. Nandurkar provided the information about revision taking place in UGC policies.

Mr. Sunil Bhor discussed about delayed centralized admission process and the way it hampers entire teaching learning process.

Mr. Rohit Kulkarni insisted on coding style of students and expected that coding style and programming skills should be taught across all branches and they should learn other aspects from their domain. He has given the example of a box and its materials and costs. He expressed satisfaction regarding project work focussing. He expected the measurement of students with respect to non-classroom activities. He along with Dr. Nandurkar discussed about the considerations of students engagement with and without teacher and translations of attendance to meaningful engagement. Mr. Rohit expressed concern about term work submission and associated waste of time, non-value addition, frustrations leading to boredom. Dr. Nandurkar told about the reforms taking place because of Continuous Comprehensive Evaluation (CCE) and printed journals which reduces burden and enjoyable learning environment. Mr. Rohit was curious about the last semester's industry experience and expressed that it is a two sided sword.

Dr. K. N. Nandurkar informed that it is challenging job to offer internship to 1100 students in industry and other alternatives like NGOs, Government offices can also engage student to solve real life problems. Since 4-5 students per industry requires 100-200 industries, it requires a proper action plan otherwise the idea back fires.

Prof. N. M. Shahane informed the members about the unique assignment given to each of SY B Tech students of computer/AI&DS/CSD to avoid copying and creating interest among students. Mr. Bhor told that the entire activity depends on the type of a students.


Mr. Vijay Jadhav, a student representative, suggested that the students should be informed about the companies and their focus area before campus interview. He has also suggested that a Post-Placement talk can be arranged for second and third year students. Students should be told about the importance of practical knowledge and extra-curricular activities. There should be mentoring from placed students by means of students to students.
