Guidelines to Authors

Types of Papers:

Authors are invited to submit manuscripts for the following sections: Research Articles, Review Papers, Case Studies, Technical Notes and Perspectives. Manuscripts should report original research that contributes significantly to the body of knowledge in the field of innovation and sustainability.

General Guidelines

- Manuscripts are accepted only in English. British English spelling and punctuation are preferred.
- Submitted manuscripts must not have been published as copyrighted material nor be submitted for consideration for publication as copyrighted material while in review by the Journal, whether in print or electronic form. By submitting a manuscript, the author(s) agree that the copyright will be transferred to JTISG if the manuscript is accepted for publication.
- The manuscript pages are expected to fall between 8 to 10 pages, including references. Manuscripts that greatly exceed the word limit will be critically reviewed with respect to length. Authors should include a word count with their manuscript.
- Abstracts of 200 – 250 words are required for all manuscripts submitted. A concise and factual abstract is required. The abstract should state briefly the purpose of the research, the principal results and major conclusions. An abstract is often presented separately from the article, so it must be able to stand alone.
- Each manuscript should have 2 to 6 keywords, using American spelling and avoiding general and plural terms and multiple concepts (avoid, for example, "and", "of"). Be sparing with abbreviations: only abbreviations firmly established in the field may be eligible.

Submission Guidelines:

- Manuscripts must be submitted in electronic form only by sending an email to: jtisg@kkwagh.edu.in
- An automatic and immediate e-mail confirmation is provided if the submission process is completed successfully. The Editor subsequently evaluates manuscripts for their compatibility with the Journal's mission and review criteria.
- The Editor typically can complete the evaluation and inform the author within two weeks of the submission of the manuscript. The Editor forwards appropriate manuscripts to one of the members of the Journal's editorial board, who handles the peer review.
- The Journal is normally able to complete the peer review process and inform the author within one month.

Format of Manuscript

Manuscripts should be compiled in the following order: title page; abstract; keywords; main text; acknowledgements; references; appendices (as appropriate); table(s) with caption(s) (on individual pages); figure caption(s) (as a list).

Title Page :

The manuscript should have a title page which includes: The name(s) of the author(s), The Title of the Manuscript, the affiliation(s) and the address(es) of the author(s), the e-mail address, contact number of the corresponding author.

- **Font:** Times New Roman, size 10 for abstract, 12 for text and headings (bold) and 14 for the title of the manuscript.
- Abbreviations should be defined at the first place of mention and used thereafter.
- Footnotes can be used to give additional information
- Acknowledgements of people, funds/grants received should be placed separately, preferably after references.
- Internationally accepted signs and symbols should be used
- All figures and tables should be properly numbered and aligned within the manuscript. The source of the table /figure should be mentioned below (in italics, if any)

Figure Captions

Figures must be numbered using Arabic numerals. Figure captions must be in 8 pt Regular font. Captions of a single line (e.g. Fig. 2) must be centred, whereas multi-line captions must be justified. Captions with figure numbers must be placed after their associated figures.

Table Captions

- Tables must be numbered as Arabic numerals. Table captions must be centred and in 8 pt bold with Small Caps. Captions with table numbers must be placed before their associated tables.
- Lengthy proofs/derivations should be avoided. If necessary, then it should be appended to the manuscript.

Referencing Style:

The IEEE Transactions referencing style will be preferred.
