1) Welcome to all members

Dr. K. N. Nandurkar welcomed Mr. Nilesh Salgaonkar, Mr. Rohit Kulkarni and Dr Rajendra Sangle.

2) Confirmation of Minutes of previous IQAC Meeting

Resolution: The copies of agenda, Minutes of Meeting of last IQAC meeting and relevant documents were circulated to all members. Prof. N. M. Shahane read out the minutes of last meeting. The minutes were confirmed and approved.

3) Review of IQAC activities (March 2025 to June 2025)

Prof. N. M. Shahane presented review of IQAC activities conducted during March 2025 to June 2025. He has briefly reported the activities carried out in last three months.

Dr. K. N. Nandurkar has suggested to float Student Satisfaction Survey a bit earlier so as to acquire more number of responses and also enquired about student's usage monitoring of facilities provided.

Dr. Rajendra Sangle enquired about data collection method for course attainment. Dr. Preeti Bhamre explain the procedure of data collection. He congratulated the six departments who got NBA Accreditation.

4) Planning of IQAC Activities (July 2025 to Sept. 2025)

Prof. N. M. Shahane presented the planning of IQAC activities for the period July 2025 to September 2025.

5) Open discussions

Mr. Nilesh Salgaonkar remarked about Quality Objective 1 that 60% students securing 60% marks in SEE & CIE depends on Quality of Students. Dr. P. D. Bhamre informed that students placement and results also show the measurable parameter for their quality.

Mr. Rohit Kulkarni told that industry absorption, progression to higher education & entrepreneurship reveal the quality of students. Mr. Salgaonkar added that there is a need to bridge industry-institute gap and to revise syllabi as per industry needs and finally the end results also matters.

Mr. Rohit Kulkarni remarked that student's communication in English is poor. They are using ChatGPT that is good but they are pros & cons of using it.

Mr. Sangle told that the communication now a days is very much influenced by ChatGPT but still there are issues which are unknown to ChatGPT. He also expressed concern to include soft skills in curriculum.

Mr. Rohit Kulkarni further suggested to make the systems closed loop and the need of mechanism to measure effects of video viewing of students. He expressed serious concern about the internship in Autonomous status and worried about the attendance of students in expert talks, industry related lectures and public lectures.

All the members agreed that six months is a good period for internship. Internship in small scale industries verses large scale industries and their usefulness was also discussed. Mr. Salgaonkar remarked that there will be a drastic effect of current internship process on next batch students as well as the companies involved and hence strict monitoring is required.

Dr. K. N. Nandurkar informed that mentor from the associated departments will be visiting the company weekly for monitoring the entire process.

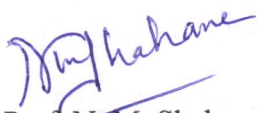
