colleges in rural villages with faculties like Kakasaheb Nagar & Chandori. These colleges are useful for the children from rural area who were deprived of higher education due to non-availability of colleges in and around their native place.

All institutes have State-of-the-Art laboratories with latest equipments, computers & internet connectivity. **THE** late Balasaheb Devram Wagh alias Bhau (1932-2022) was born in the legendary family of Padmashri Karmaveer Kakasaheb Wagh.

He was an Agriculture graduate & started his career in cooperative & agriculture development gathering field experience in these sectors. Due to his scientific temper & rational approach, he succeeded in increasing the productivity of various sugar factories & brought them into the limelight.

Later, he founded the K K Wagh Education Society in 1970 & played an instrumental role in shaping this society. Owing to his dedicated efforts, able stewardship & interest in providing students with diverse fields of education like Engineering, Agriculture, Pharmacy, Polytechnics, Senior Colleges & school education (SSC & CBSE schools). The K K Wagh Education Society could establish 9 campuses by 2022.

A man of principles, he brought the light of knowledge into the lives of the rural population by providing education, especially for girls, at an affordable cost. His main focus was always on giving "Quality education to all students".

Being a man who believed in top quality, he strived so that the mark of K. K. Wagh is spread across the globe from rural areas. # Industry-Institute Interaction

## 1.0 Visit to Industries by K K Wagh leaders -

During the academic year 2024-25, K K Wagh team consisting of Principal, Deans, HODs TPO, T&P Coordinators and Senior Faculties visited around 150+ companies with an objective of enhancing K K Wagh-Industry Interactions. Outcome of these industrial visits are to explore Internships and Placement Opportunities, Expert Lectures, Industry Certification Courses and Establishment of Centre of Excellence and Joint Projects. The focus was on enhancing the existing relations and connecting with new industries. The idea was to get the inputs from industry leaders for enhancing capabilities of our students and making them more employable.

## 2.0 AICTE-IDEA Lab:

This lab is spread over 5000 Sqft and has major equipment like 3-D Printers, 3-D Scanners, Laser Cutting Machine, PCB Milling, Wood Router, Lathe machines, Drone programming, Arduino Programming, and AR/VR with an investment of Rs. 1.1 Cr. The AICTE IDEA lab is also visited by eminent industry leaders and professionals, academicians, and entrepreneurs for guiding students and faculty members, collaborating on projects, etc.

## 3.0 Institute Innovation Council in KKWIEER:

An institute-innovation council is established in KKWIEER in collaboration with the Ministry of Human Resource Development, India. Primarily, IICs' role is to engage a large number of faculty, students and staff in various innovation and entrepreneurship-related activities such as ideation, Problem-solving, Proof of Concept development, Design Thinking, IPR, project handling and management at the Pre-incubation/Incubation stage, etc., so that innovation and entrepreneurship ecosystem gets established and stabilized in HEIs. The KKWIEER has received a 4-star ranking during 2023-24 for doing innovative activities.

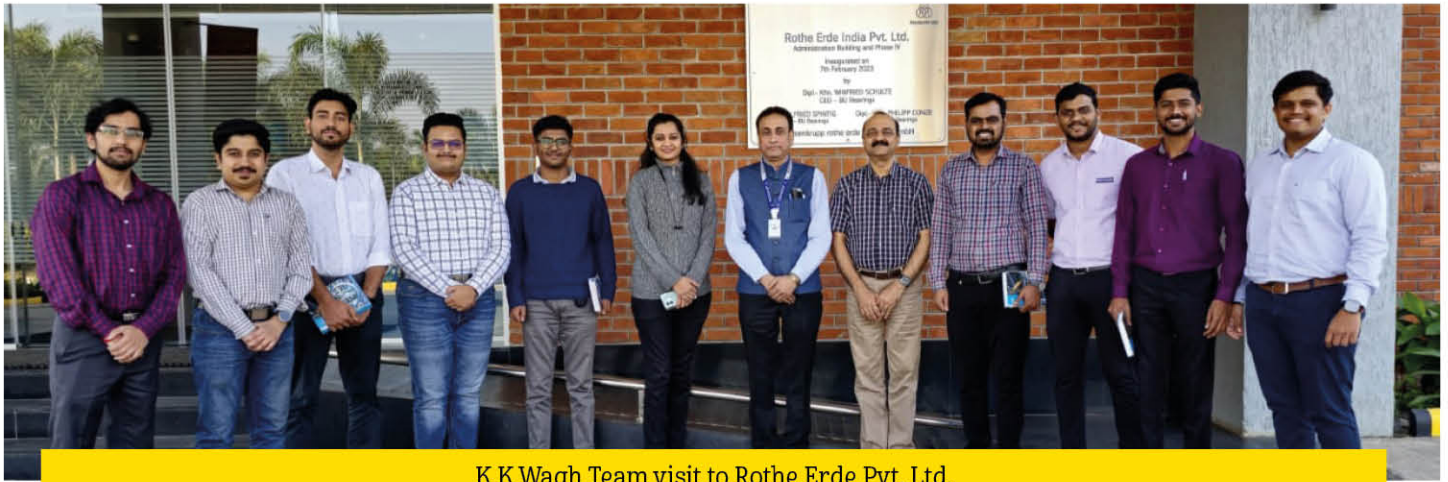

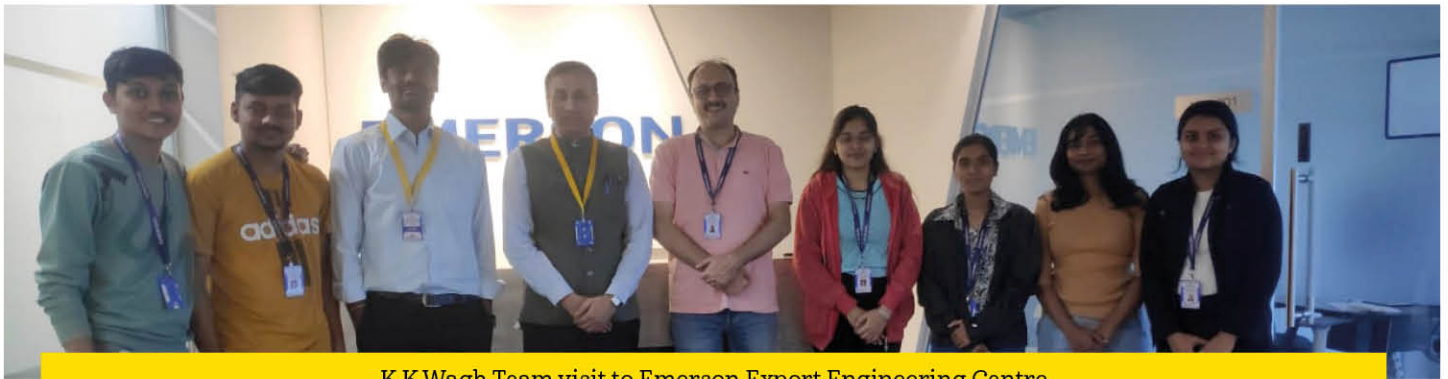

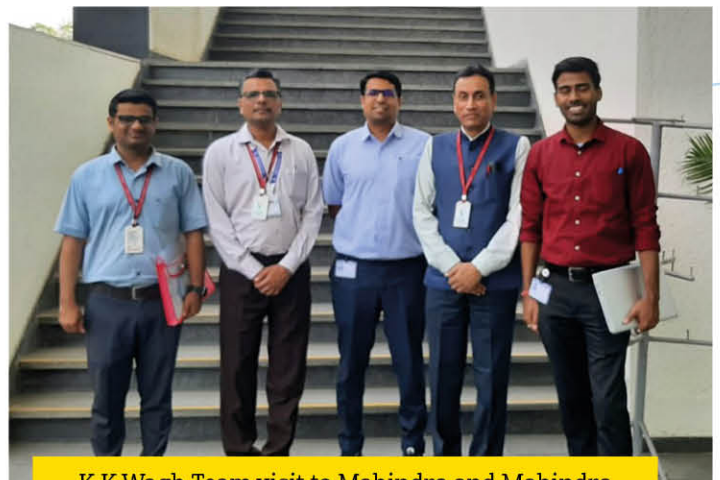

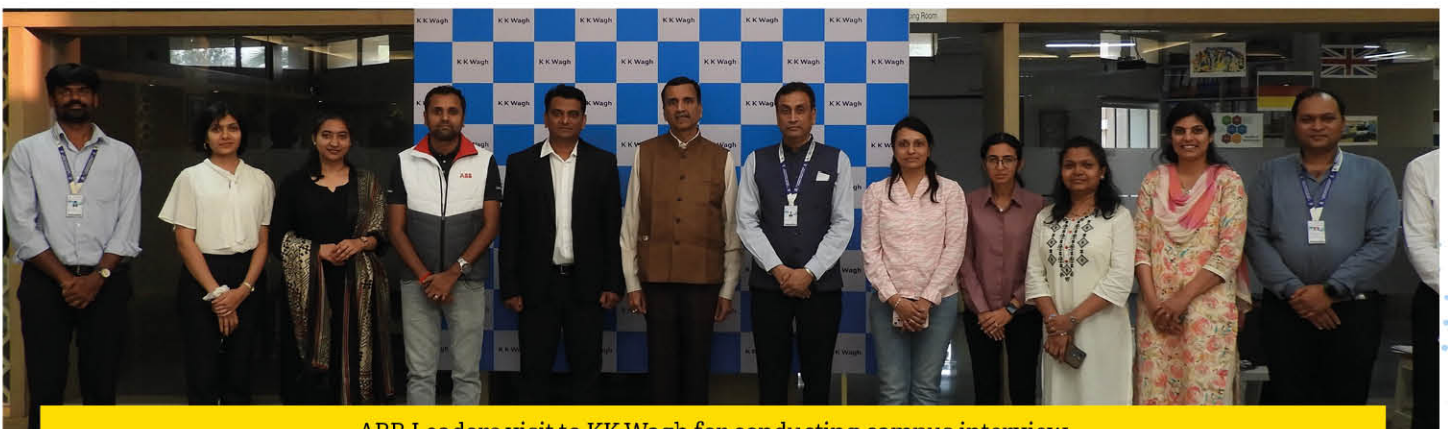
