K.K. Wagh Institute Achieves a Hatrick of Victories in Smart India Hackathon

Smart India Hackathon (SIH), the world's largest open innovation model, reflects Prime Minister Narendra Modi's vision of empowering the youth to lead India towards innovation and self-reliance. SIH 2024 witnessed an overwhelming response, with nearly 88,000 teams and over 5 lakh students participating. Around 32,000 problem statements were attempted, with 2,600 higher education institutions (HEIs) registered and 54 ministries, industries, PSUs, and state departments contributing to the initiative.

In this national celebration of innovation, K.K. Wagh Institute of Engineering Education and Research achieved another remarkable milestone. This year, 10 teams from the institute were selected for the SIH 2024 Grand Finale, competing in various problem statements.
